

How to Download Free eBooks & Audiobooks to Your Nook

The Minuteman Library Network and the Watertown Free Public Library subscribe to a service called Overdrive. Overdrive allows you to check out free eBooks and audiobooks to your device.

How to Download an eBook:

1. Download **Adobe Digital Editions** <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/> to your PC or Mac (requires Adobe Flash Player to install). Follow the installation instructions.
2. Once installed, Adobe Digital Editions will automatically start. Follow the setup wizard. You will need to activate the software with your Adobe ID or create an Adobe ID.
3. Go to the Watertown Free Public Library's website: www.watertownlib.org
4. Scroll down and click on the **Overdrive** logo on the right-hand side of the page



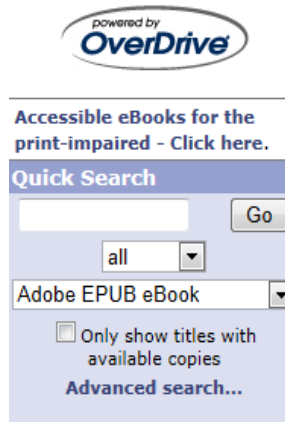
5. Click **Sign In** on the upper right-hand corner of the page so that you will see all of the eBooks owned by the Minuteman Library Network and the Watertown Free Public Library
6. Enter your **Library Card Number** and **PIN**

If you forgot your PIN, we can reset it at the circulation desk or reference desk

- If you want to browse for the perfect eBook, click on one of the categories along the left side of the page. If you want to view all eBooks, scroll down to the bottom and click on **View all eBooks**



- If you have a title/author in mind, do a quick search on the top left side of the page and set the dropdown menu to **Adobe EPUB eBook**. You can also choose to show only books currently checked in.

- To download, click the **Add to Cart** link to the right of Adobe EPUB eBook then click **Proceed to Checkout**
- Choose how long you want the item for (7, 14 or 21 days) then click **Confirm Check Out**
- Click on **Download** and save it to your PC or Mac
- Double click the downloaded file to open it in Adobe Digital Editions
- Connect your Nook to the computer via USB cord (make sure the Nook is on)
- Click **Authorize Device**. It will add an icon for your Nook below your bookshelf
- Make sure you are in **Library View**. If you aren't, click on **Library View** in the upper left corner.
- Find the title you want to transfer and click and drag it to the Nook icon below your bookshelf then disconnect your Nook from your PC or Mac

How to Download an Audiobook:

Note: Audiobooks are only compatible with Nook Color & Nook 1st Edition

1. Download the **Overdrive Media Console** <http://www.overdrive.com/software/omc/> to your PC or Mac. Follow the installation instructions.
2. Go to the Watertown Free Public Library's website: www.watertownlib.org
3. Scroll down and click on the **Overdrive** logo on the right-hand side of the page



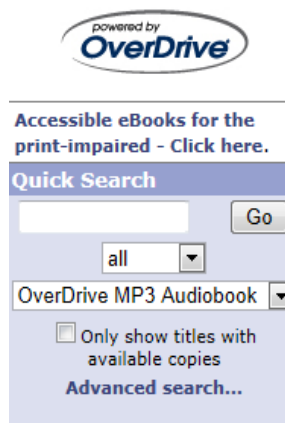
4. Click **Sign In** on the upper right-hand corner of the page so that you will see all of the Audiobooks owned by the Minuteman Library Network and the Watertown Free Public Library
5. Enter your **Library Card Number** and **PIN**


6. Formats compatible with the Nook are: Adobe EPUB, Adobe PDF and MP3 Audiobook
7. If you want to browse for the perfect Audiobook, click on one of the categories along the left side of the page. If you want to view all Audiobooks, scroll down to the bottom and click on **View all MP3 Audiobooks**



8. If you have a title/author in mind, do a quick search on the top left side of the page and set the dropdown menu to **Overdrive MP3 Audiobook**. You can also choose to show only Audiobooks currently checked in.

10. To download, click the **Add to Cart** link to the right of MP3 Audiobook then click **Proceed to Checkout**
11. Choose how long you want the item for (7 or 14 days) then click **Confirm Check Out**
12. Click on **Download** and choose **Open** (Overdrive Media Console will start automatically)
13. From the Get Media box that opens, choose where to save the audiobook and which parts to download
14. Connect your Nook to the computer via USB cord (make sure the Nook is on)
15. Make sure the title is selected, click on **Transfer** then follow the transfer instructions
16. Disconnect your Nook from your PC or Mac

Frequently Asked Questions

How is an Adobe EPUB eBook different from a PDF eBook?

Adobe EPUB eBooks have reflowable text, which means that you can change the font, resize the text, or alter the size of your display and the text of the Adobe EPUB eBook 'reflows' to fill the screen.

Will I be notified before my loan expires?

Yes. Three days before the end of the loan period, we will send a courtesy reminder e-mail about the loan expiration. Once the loan period has ended, an additional e-mail notification will be sent.

What happens when my loan expires? Do I get charged for late returns?

No, there are no fees charged for late items. For Nook, once the expiration date is reached, your title will automatically be returned. It will still show up on any devices you transferred it to, but you will be unable to open it. Audiobooks cannot be returned early.

How do I return eBooks early?

Open Adobe Digital Editions then select the [Library View](#) icon (top left). Go to the [Borrowed](#) heading then click on the triangle in the upper left of the eBook you want to return. Select [Return Borrowed Item](#).

May I renew the items I have checked out?

Titles cannot be renewed, but you can check them out again when the checkout period ends.

Can I download a title multiple times during the checkout period?

Yes. Go to the Overdrive website, click on [My Digital Media Account](#) then [My Checked Out Items](#).

How long will a title remain in my cart?

Once you add a title to your cart, it will remain there for 30 minutes before it is automatically removed.

How many titles can I have checked out at the same time?

You can have up to 5 titles checked out at any given time.

How many items can I place on hold at the same time?

You can place up to 5 titles on hold at a time.

How do I download an eBook I've placed on hold?

Go to the Overdrive website, click on [My Digital Media Account](#) then [My Requests](#). This page lists all titles that you have currently placed on hold. You'll receive an email notification once a title you have placed on hold becomes available. Note that if a title has become available since you placed the hold, an [Add to Cart](#) link will be displayed next to the available title. Use this link to add the title to your cart and check out. Items you place on hold will be kept in your cart for 5 days after the notification email is sent.

How do I cancel a hold?

1. Go to the Overdrive page and click on [My Digital Media Account](#)
2. Click the [My Requests](#) link. The titles that you have currently placed on hold are displayed.
3. Click a title's [Remove](#) link to cancel the hold.
