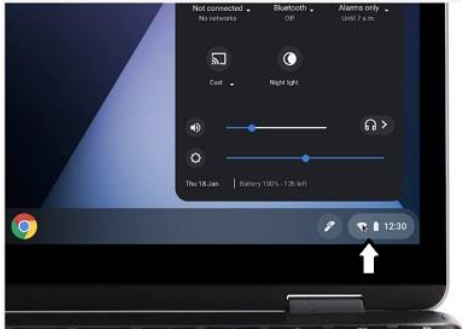
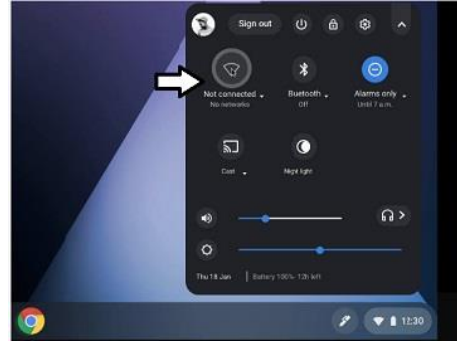


How to connect to Wi-Fi on a Chromebook

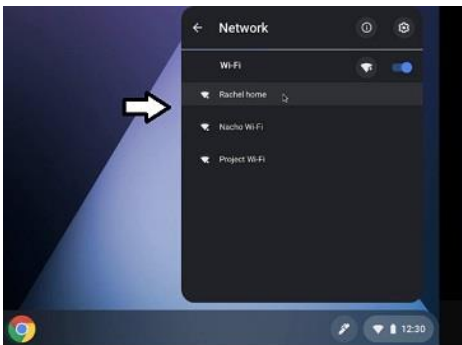
Step 1- Click on the Quick Settings Panel at the bottom right of your screen.



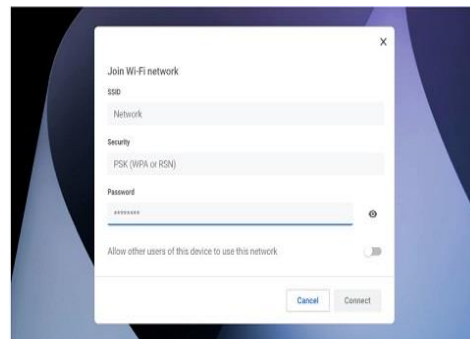
Step 2- Click on “no-network.”



Step 3- Select your Wi-Fi Network.



Step 4- Enter the password if it asks for one

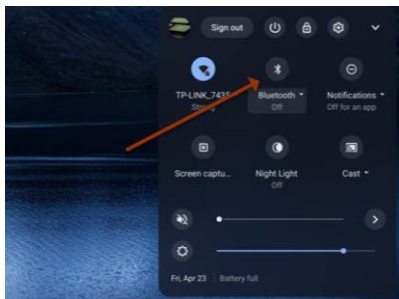


How to connect to Bluetooth on a Chromebook

Step 1

Make sure the **Bluetooth device** you want to connect is on nearby and ready to pair

Step 2



Click on the **Quick Settings Panel** at the bottom right of your screen

Step 3

Click **Bluetooth**.







Step 4

Select your Bluetooth accessory.





Step 5

Follow any additional instructions on screen.


Popular shortcuts

- Take a screenshot: **Press Ctrl + Show Windows** 
- Take a partial screenshot: **Press Shift + Ctrl + Show windows** , then click and drag.
- Turn Caps Lock on or off: **Press Search**  **+ Alt.**
Or press Launcher  **+ Alt.**
- Lock your screen: **Press Search**  **+ L.**
Or press Launcher  **+ L.**
- Sign out of your Google Account: **Press Shift + Ctrl + q (twice).**
- See all keyboard shortcuts: **Press Ctrl + Alt + / (forward slash).**

Accessibility

- Turn Chrome Vox (spoken feedback) on or off
Ctrl + Alt + z
- Turn on high contrast mode
Search  **+ Ctrl + h (or)**
Launcher  **+ Ctrl + h**
- Magnify your whole screen
Ctrl + Search  **+ m (or)**
Ctrl + Launcher  **+ m**

Printing at home

- To print the page, image, or document you're viewing, press **Ctrl + p**
- Next to "Destination," select the Down arrow 
- Select See more...
- Choose your printer. Tip: Some printers will automatically show up on this list. If you don't see your printer on the list, you can select Manage.
- Select Print.

If printing at the library, select the Wireless Printing bookmark in the top left of the browser window and follow the instructions on the screen.
